

## **Coop4edu**

### **Ioannina workshop / 24.10.2019**

#### **Task**

The workshop aimed at engaging the participants to collaboratively work with the following questions:

- How do you consider the term “social impact”? How do social enterprises contribute to that?
- How could a business incubator support social enterprises?
- What are the benefits of a social enterprise?
- What are the main differences between conventional enterprises and social enterprises?
- What is the role of the social and solidarity economy on tackling unemployment rates?

The participants were supported by a group of moderators and facilitators throughout the process.

#### **The workshop**

The participants were split into five (5) groups working on five (5) different questions. In each table/workstation, a moderator was in charge of harvesting the information and collecting the participant’s answers in order to fill in the flipcharts. The moderators were selected among the workshop participants. Together with the moderator, a facilitator was also available in each workstation, aiming on explaining the process to the participants, facilitate the brainstorming session and support the moderator when needed.

Each group had 10 minutes to work on each question before moving to the next workstation. The moderators and the facilitators were not part of the rolling process as they had to remain in their corresponding workstations. After approximately 60 minutes, all five groups had the opportunity to work with the five questions.

During the second phase of the workshop, the groups were merged and the five moderators shared the key finding of each question.
